The Telegraph Engineering Service (Group-B)
Recruitment Rules 1981

G.S.R.323(E) - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to atticle 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Telegraph Engineering Service (Class II) Recruitment Rules, 1966, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Telegraph Engineering Service, Group'B' in the posts and Telegraphs Depurtment, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement: (1) These rules may be called the Telegraph Eng. neering Service (Group-'B' posts)
 Recruitment Bules, 1981.
- (2) They shall come into force on the data of their publication in the Official G_{azette} .
- 2. Number . Classification and scale of pay-The number of posts, its classification, and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as a specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, probation and promotion-The method of recruitment, age limit and other matters connected with the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said schedule and Appendix I to III to these Rules.
- 4. Qualification:- Ho person-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or entered into or (b) who having a spouse living has entered into or

(b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the law personal/applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of the rule.

5. Power to relax: Where the Central Covernment is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient as to do, it may, by order for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the central Government from time to time in this regard.

APPENDIX -I

Except as otherwise provided in Appendix II in respect of recruitmant to the posts reserved for Ex. Company employees of the Talephone Districts of Bombay and Calcutta, recruitment to the Barvice shall be by promotion from the officials mentioned in paragraph 3 by the method of selection as indicated in paragraph 2.

2(i) 66-2/3 per cent by a duly constituted Departmental Promotion Committies from the officials who have qualified in the Departmental qualifying Examination.

(11) 33-1/3 percent through Limited Departmental competitive Axamination on the basis of relative merit.

(iii) The increase seniority of the officials who have qualified in the Departmental Qualifying Examination and those who have qualified in the Limited Departmental competitive examination shall be in the ratio 2:1 starting with the officers selected by the method of selection by the Departmental Promotion Committee on the basis of Departmental qualifying examination,

- 3. The following categories of officials whall be eligible for consideration for promotion to the service:-
- (i) Junior Engineers.

4. There shall be normally one examination, consisting of two parts called. Qualifying-cum-Competitive *xamination for promotion to the service and in accordance with the syllabus prescribed in Appendix III to these rules.

Nota: After the commencement of those rules, the first two examinations shall only be competitive for which the eligibility shall be restricted to only those officers who have already qualified in the Departmental qualifying Examination held before the

commencement of these rules.

- 5. The eligibility for appearing in each part of the examination shall be as:-
 - (a) Departmental qualifying Examination:
 - .(i) Junior Engineers who have completed five years of regular service in the grade on the first of January of the year which the examination is held.
 - (ii) Ex company officials who have put in a minimum
