Counsel for the petitioners says that the order passed by this Court on 3.8.2005 giving directions to the respondent not to revert the petitioners from their present post is being misconstrued by the respondents and the respondents have been promoting the persons junior to the petitioners by taking the shelter under the said order which states that the petitioners cannot be reverted back from their present post.
